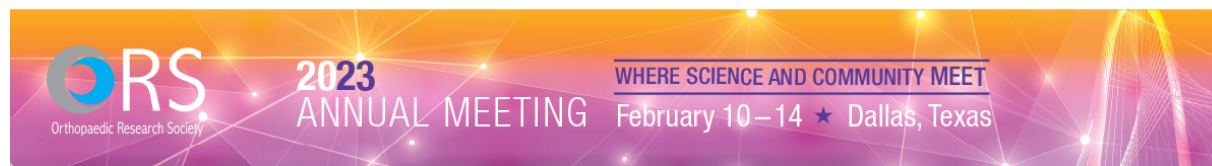

Meniscus Section Virtual Mini-Symposium Recap

This spring, the section started a new mini-virtual seminar series on a broad research area of the meniscus, with a primary goal to provide a platform for trainees to showcase their research to the community. The virtual mini-symposium was a great success!!

The event started with a welcome note from **Drs. Francesco Travascio, Ph.D.**, and **Raghunatha Yammani, Ph.D.**, mini-symposium organizers, followed by three excellent short talks.

Serafina Lopez (graduate Student) from Cornell University delivered the first virtual mini-talk highlighting the role of GAGs on the mechanical properties of the engineered meniscal enthesis.

Dr. Rebecca Irwin, Ph.D. from Cornell University, presented her outstanding work on the effect of cyclic tensile stretch inner and outer Zone Porcine Meniscus Cells to Offsets the Inflammatory Effects of IL-1 α .

Finally, **Dr. Hun-Jin Jeong, Ph.D.** from Columbia University, gave an insight into the comprehensive volumetric analysis of matrix structure and composition in knee meniscus.

We had a great session on “Sex and Race Disparities on Meniscus Health: Lessons from Other Connective Tissues” featuring wonderful talks by Dr. Monica Maly (University of Waterloo), Dr. Keith Baar (University of California Davis), and Dr. Paula Hernandez (UT Southwestern). Virtual scientific sessions such as this are FREE for ORS members so be sure to take advantage of these sessions!

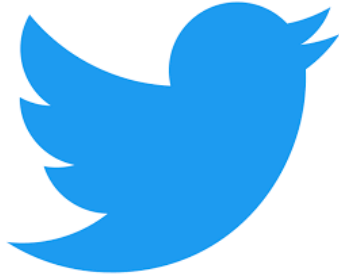
